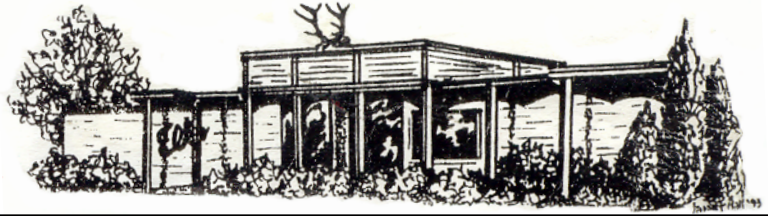

We also have many upcoming events in December at our Lodge. Below are just a few of the highlights:

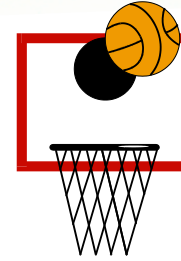



We have the final numbers for the dinner dance and silent auction. We raised \$3,884.00 for ENF. This is quite an accomplishment and I again would like to thank the committee members who worked so hard to make this happen and all who attended.

And now, what's up for Dec.? Thinking about holiday shopping already? The ENF has good news for you. On Dec. 10-11, Borders Books, Music and Movies will **donate 15%** of sales purchased in-store and online with a special voucher to the **Elks National Foundation**.

If you're shopping online, use the online code ELNF1210G at checkout. Additional copies of the voucher are also available at [www.elks.org/enf](http://www.elks.org/enf). To benefit the ENF, vouchers or online codes **must** be used at the time of purchase.

**ENF tidbit:** During the 2009-10 lodge year, the Elks of WA donated \$195,516.16 to the ENF. This year, the Foundation will give back the following: State Charities Grant (therapy program) \$104,140; Special Projects Grant \$61,850; Bonus Grant \$46,020; Most Valuable Student Scholarships \$52,000; and Legacy Scholarships \$24,000. ### **Washington ELKS Therapy Program for Children, Inc.**

*The Major Project for over 50 years, provides home based Occupational or Physical Therapy to children with disabilities at no cost to their families.*



Mathias started in physical therapy at about 5 months old. He had torticollis which is a twisted neck in which the head is turned to one side while the chin is turned to the other. Later we learned that he also had tightening around his surgical scar from his open heart surgery. Because of Elks services, Mathias now has no sign of torticollis or the tightening around his surgical scar. If it wasn't for these services Mathias may have never been able to receive care for his problems. We had just moved here and were sharing one car, which my husband was taking to work. Our insurance wasn't that good at the time and we didn't qualify for any state assistance. It was a rough time so Elks therapy was a life saver for us. Because of the therapist's hard work, devotion and Elks funds, Mathias is a happy, healthy child now with no PT difficulties.

When we found our our little Ellie also had torticollis, my heart sank. We tried to get outside services, but Ellie wasn't very cooperative with



these providers and was more traumatized by the attempted PT. We then contacted Elks Therapy when she was 3 months old and they have been working with her ever since. Ellie's neck has improved and she has almost full range now. Her head shape has also improved. Ellie is making strides every day. The PT is also working with her legs. With Elks Therapy services my children have been able to reach their full potential. Thank you Elks Therapy and to those who help make these services available for families like mine. Our whole family thanks you. The Elks are true angels on earth.

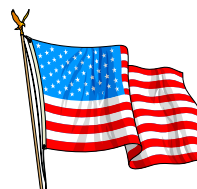
